

RESOLUTION NO. 06-07

A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF
THE SCOTTS VALLEY WATER DISTRICT CALLING FOR
TEN PERCENT VOLUNTARY WATER CONSERVATION SAVINGS IN 2007

RESOLVED by the Board of Directors of the Scotts Valley Water District, Santa Cruz County, California, that:

WHEREAS, the Board of Directors in April 2007 approved Resolution No. 05-07, declaring May 2007 as "WATER AWARENESS MONTH" and urging all citizens and customers of the Scotts Valley Water District to join with other local water organizations in their effort to help Californians conserve and use water wisely; and

WHEREAS, Resolution No. 05-07 recognizes that California will experience periodic droughts and that water conservation is critical at all times, but particularly so during droughts; and,


WHEREAS, following a cycle of normal and above average rainfall years, precipitation this year in the Scotts Valley area totals only half that of a normal year, indicating the importance of a heightened water conservation effort by all District citizens and customers; and

WHEREAS, the District's "2005 Urban Water Management Plan and Water Shortage Contingency Plan" requires mandatory conservation reductions of potable water use during the second year of a drought and encourages proactive voluntary water conservation measures for potable supplies at earlier drought stages.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Board of Directors of the Scotts Valley Water District of Scotts Valley, California, calls upon all District citizens and customers to undertake voluntary water conservation measures to achieve a ten percent reduction in potable water use during 2007.
