



Scotts Valley Water District Weather-Based Irrigation Devices Rebate Requirements

Weather Based Irrigation Devices (WBIDs)

Install an approved Weather Based Irrigation Device and qualify for a credit of between \$100 and \$500. Approved credit is applied to your water bill. To schedule a pre-installation inspection call 831-438-2363.

What are the rebate requirements?

- The controller must be used in retrofitting an existing landscape previously irrigated using a timer, traditional irrigation controller, or similar device or irrigated without a WBIC.
- Rebate is based on summer usage: up to \$100 if summer outdoor use is within the range 250-749 gallons per day (gpd); up to \$250 if within the range 750-2,999 gpd; up to \$500 if 3,000 gpd or greater.
- Less than 250 gpd summer outdoor use does not qualify.
- No credit will be given for labor, programming, signaling fees or for other installation or maintenance costs.
- Original receipt must accompany rebate credit application.
- Customer must allow a pre and post installation inspection.
