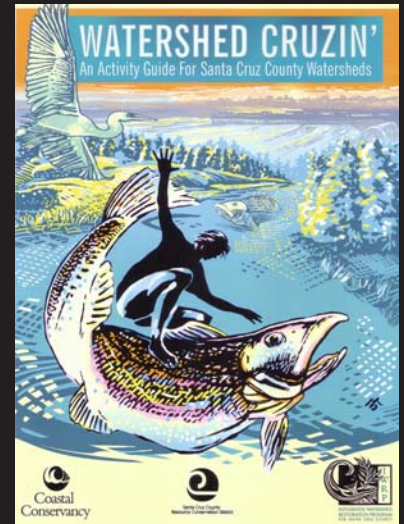
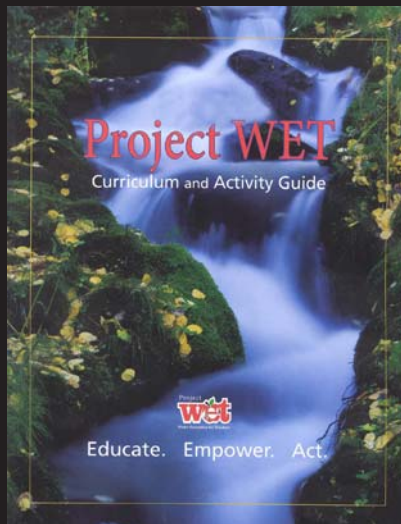
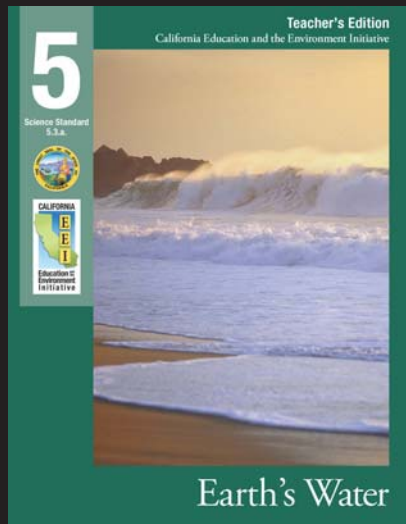


3 in 1 Water Education Workshop

Three environmental education curriculums come together on February 25 in this FREE 6-hour workshop about water.



- 1 **Project WET (Water Education for Teachers) Curriculum and Activity Guide** (K-12 grade): international, interdisciplinary, curriculum that specializes in hands-on supplementary activities about water.
- 2 **California Environmental Education Initiative Curriculum (EEI)** is a new state approved replacement curriculum that uses environmental education concepts to teach the California state standards to mastery. The units on water for 4th - 6th grade will be highlighted.
- 3 **Watershed Cruzin': An Activity Guide to Santa Cruz County Watersheds** teaches classroom and field-based science activities for fourth through twelfth grade to help students explore their local watersheds.
